Equivalence of Post-Secondary diplomas awarded abroad for Romanian citizens

For **sectoral professions** - physician, dentist, pharmacist, general care nurse, midwife, veterinary surgeon and architect - as well as for **other regulated professions** and mentioned in Law no. 200/2004, as amended and supplemented, postgraduate and vocational school diplomas obtained in the Member States of the European Union, the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation shall be equated with the <u>appropriate competent authorities</u>.

3. Study document for previous school cycle

- copy, if the study document is issued in Romanian, English, French,
 Spanish, Italian language
- copy and certified translation in Romanian for the documents issued in other languages
- **4. Proof of completion of all study levels** (transcript of all years/certificate of each level including course description and skills acquired); study document showing the name of completed courses, length of study, course descriptions and skills acquired
 - copy, if the study document is issued in Romanian, English, French,
 Spanish, Italian language
 - copy and certified translation in Romanian for the documents issued in other languages

5. Identification paper - copy

- passport / identity card
- proof of legal name change, if applicable, copy for documents in Romanian language / English / French / Spanish / Italian, and authorized translation in Romanian for other languages

Authentication of study documents

- 1. Diplomas from Moldova do not need any form of authentication. Diplomas issued before 2008 (and diplomas issued after 2008 which cannot be <u>verified on line</u>) shall be accompanied by a <u>Certificate of Authenticity from the Ministry of Education of Moldova</u> which shall be submitted, starting on 01.04.2019, in copy;
- 2. The <u>Hague Apostille</u> is requested for diplomas from <u>countries which</u> <u>are parties to the Hague Apostille</u>, issued by the <u>competent authorities</u> in the issuing countries. The Hague Apostille is requested for diplomas from Italy, Greece, Spain, Portugal and Cyprus;
- 3. Diplomas issued in countries which are not parties to the Hague Apostille Convention shall be <u>authenticated</u> or accompanied by an authentication certificate from by the competent authorities in the issuing countries:
 - Legalization/Authentication is done by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country, the Embassy/Consular Office of Romania in the issuing country and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs or by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the issuing country, the issuing country's Embassy/Consular Office in Romania and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs; for countries where Romania does not have a diplomatic mission or countries which do not have diplomatic missions in Romania, the study documents shall be legalized by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country;
 - Legalization/Authentication exemption is allowed under the law of an international treaty to which Romania is party or on a reciprocity basis.

Evaluation of documents

The processing time is 30 days from the date of registration of the application, which should include proper and complete documents.

If considerable research or correspondence to obtain necessary information is required, during unusually busy periods or when circumstances beyond our control prevail, the time span as indicated above may be extended.

Duplicate release

In case of loss, partial or complete damage of the certificate, a duplicate can be issued upon submission of official request and the following documents: copy of the diploma which was recognised; copy of personal identity document; a notary statement regarding the loss or damage of the certificate – original.

Appealing procedure

The appeals shall be submitted to the M.E.C. Registry within 45 working days from the date of issue of the recognition / equivalence certificate and, respectively, from the date of notifying the reasons for non-recognition. The deadline for resolving the appeals is 60 working days from their registration with CNRED. The term of settlement can be extended in justified cases, the applicant being notified in writing, through postal services or electronic mail.
